

2009 NAMBA Nationals Entry Form

The 2009 NAMBA Nationals will be conducted July 11-18 at Gissberg Twin Lakes County Park, Smokey Point WA. This site is in the vicinity of a growing district of commerce. In the past 2 years, many new stores have been opened in an area that was previously farmland. The site is within walking distance of Costco, Red Robin, Subway, IHOP, and a variety of shopping venues. Just a few miles south is the Tulalip Casino/Resort, the largest casino in the Northwest.

The members of District 8 invite you to join us for an action packed week of racing and fun. To ensure your reservation for NAMBA's premier event of 2009, the Official 2009 Nationals Entry Form, and entry fee is requested **no later than June 12**. Only entries with payment received postmarked by that date will be accepted. List channel by number only or 2.4 MHz. An entry conformation will be sent to you after the entries are finalized.

The course for this race will be the official NAMBA six laps, 1/6 of a mile course. The milling procedure will be full lap or 1/2 lap patterns that include passing the start/finish buoy. There will be a 2:00 min. mill clock followed by a 30 sec. start clock. 6 penalty free laps will constitute a race. The electric classes will run the same course and amount of laps. All electric boats will be placed in the water. There will be a 30 second count down to the start. Boats must stay on plane once they leave the launch area.

Only Official NAMBA rules and the 92db sound level will apply. Boats in the Unlimited Scale Hydro class will be measured according to the Master Hull Roster (It is a copy of the RCU roster).

Scale Unlimited Hydroplanes are encouraged to participate in the "Peoples' Choice" and Concourse judging on Friday. There will be a BBQ at the race site that evening. A Peoples' Choice award will be presented to the boat receiving the most votes. Concourse judging awards will be presented to third place. Boats entered in these events must have pictures documenting boat/paint. To be eligible to win Concourse your boat must score at least 25 points on race day. Scale Unlimited Hydroplane will follow the LOVE plan. This format includes four rounds of heat racing followed by: one main event, one semi main (winner bumps to main) and one consolation heat. Classic Thunder boats will also run the LOVE plan.

We will be offering 3 other classes not normally run. The first class is Sport 18 RTR. This class will provide sport boaters an opportunity to race their \$300 boats at a national event. We also will have 2 fast electric classes, P mono and P Spec Hydro. P mono follows the NAMBA rulebook. P Spec Hydro will follow the rules provided in the entry packet.

The National Event fee includes your first boat entry, Nationals commemorative pin, patch, and race program. The race entry fee is \$10 for each additional boat and must be paid in addition to the Nationals Event fee. Nitro and Gas Marathon are \$20.00 per team. They will follow the Team Marathon rules with one exception; only G1 Gas Mono entries are allowed in the Gas Marathon Event.

You are invited to a Welcome Party on Monday July 13th at the Medallion Hotel. Wednesday evening will have a buffet meal at the paddle boat race at the Medallion Hotel pool. The Awards' Banquet will be held on Saturday July 18th at the Medallion Hotel.

Please remember to bring your NAMBA membership card. Verification of current membership is required. Single event Membership applications and payment should be included with the entry form. Single Event Form can be downloaded from www.NAMBA.com. This insurance will only be valid for the duration of the NAMBA Nationals event.

Snohomish County ordinance prohibits consuming alcohol at the race site. Drinking alcohol at the park is grounds for banishment from the event. To minimize wear and tear in the race site, participant vehicles will not be allowed to enter. A vehicle to tow trailers to the race site will be utilized. There will be a daily transport vehicle for those without trailers. You will park your vehicle in the parking lot and walk to the race site. Trailers will be allowed to stay within the race site area for the duration of the event. Security will be provided.

Race packets will be available for pick up at the race site information booth starting July 10th. Please have your NAMBA Membership Card available. It will be used for verification and is required to receive your packet.

A minimum of 5 boats is required to qualify a class to be raced at the 2009 NAMBA Nationals. If a class does not make the 5-boat minimum, those who entered will be notified and entry fee refunded.

The 2009 NAMBA National Entry Forms must be completed and postmarked on or before June 12. Any changes to your entry data must be made in writing and post marked prior to the entry deadline of June 12 No telephone or email entries will be accepted. Cancellations must be made by the entry deadline

RTR Sport 18 Rules for 2009 NAMBA Nationals

1. Boats must be purchased as a ready to run and available through major hobby distributors. These are the only boats that can be raced: the ProBoat series (Miss Budweiser, Miss Llummar, Elam, and Formula) and the AquaCraft Miss Vegas. Should a new RTR 18 hydroplane be released prior to the event a decision will be made regarding its status.
2. Engine must be the O.E.M. engine for the boat.
3. Changes to the hull by adding material or removing material are permitted.
4. Relocating any of the major components is allowed – radio box, fuel tank/s, engine.
5. Running hardware can be changed or replaced.
6. Wings included with the original kit are optional.
7. Exhaust system must be the O.E.M. system installed with the complete RTR kit.
8. Boats will meet NAMBA noise abatement rules. An after market muffler to meet the established noise level is allowed.

P Spec Hydro Class Racing Rules

P-Spec Power Specifications

1) Motor Specifications

The intent of the P-Spec Motor Specifications is to define a motor and Electronic Speed Control (ESC) package to be used in Limited Spec class racing. These rules are intended to either supersede, or be in addition to, any rules pertaining to motors for a given class, as specified within the rules for that class.

Motors and ESCs in these specifications shall be based on readily available parts from past, current, and/or future Ready-to-Run offerings by various manufactures. Only motors and ESCs on the approved motor list shall be allowed.

Motors and ESCs may be mixed and matched amongst the approved parts as desired.

Motors and ESCs are intended to be used as they are supplied. Therefore, no alterations or modifications are allowed, unless specifically stated in these rules. Motor shall be directly connected to the output drive shaft, no gear/belt over/under drives will be allowed.

3) Approved Electronic Speed Controls (ESC)

ProBoat

PBR3309 45 amp brushless ESC

AquaCraft

AQUM7010 AquaCraft 45 amp waterproof ESC

AQUM7011 AquaCraft 60 amp water cooled/proof ESC

4) Cooling

Motors and ESCs may be cooled as desired. Water jackets, cooling plates, electronic fans, etc., may be added as desired, so long as they don't perform an otherwise illegal function.

5) **Contacts and Wiring**

Originally supplied contacts may be replaced.

Wire length on the power and phase leads may be altered to facilitate installation.

If lengthening the original wires, additional wire may be added to the factory supplied wires.

If shortening the original wires, the final contact to the Motor or ESC must be made using the original wiring.

The intent of this rule is to prevent the removal and replacement of the original wiring in its entirety, by requiring that the final contact to the Motor or ESC be made by the original wiring.

6) **Battery**

Batteries shall conform to NAMBA P power rules.

7) **Hull**

Hulls shall conform to NAMBA P hull limits.
